Medic: A medic will be onsite at the start of the horse show until the finish of the horse show.

Entry Fees: \$20.00 per class. \$25.00 office fee per rider, \$25.00 medic fee per rider

Entry Submittals: Email your entries to the show secretary giddyupngo@att.net by 8:00 PM on Wednesday, October 4. *Preregistration requires no prepayment or obligation to show.* All entries received after 8:00 PM on Wednesday will be charged a late fee of \$50.00 in addition to all other fees.

Membership Requirements: All riders must be current Centex members in order to compete in the show. Dues are \$25.00 for families and \$20.00 for individuals and may be paid at the show or sent to the Association Secretary. No points will be credited prior to payment of dues and payment of dues is solely the responsibility of the member.

Payment: Bring a blank check to the show. DO NOT fill out the check before you arrive. Credit cards and cash are not accepted.

Negative Coggins: A negative Coggins test is required for all horses on the property regardless of their entry status.

Check In: Check-in at the office is required upon arrival on the property to secure a show number for your horse and to verify all information pertinent to you and your horse is correct. You must check in before warming up or your first ride.

Prizes: Trophies and ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Championship trophy and ribbon and reserve ribbon will be awarded in each division in accordance with USEF Rule XXIV. Chapter VII.

Class Adds and Scratches: Adds and scratches may be made at the paddock or in the office.

Show Cancellations/Scratches: Show cancellations/scratches will be allowed up until the show number has been picked up. If you must scratch your entry once your number has been assigned at the show, the office/medic fee must still be paid.

Attire: Riding coats are required unless verbally waived by show management. All exhibitors must wear headgear in accordance with Equestrian rule G318. A polo shirt with a collar may be substituted for a riding shirt, however, T-shirts are not acceptable

Management reserves the right to cancel classes based on the the number of entries.

Exhibitors are encouraged to discuss their views with the Manager.

Hunter Classes

Warm-up Hunter Classes

Open to all. Each horse may be ridden once in each warm-up class. Warm-up cards will remain open throughout the day and the fences will be set at the current class height.

Pile of Poles Hunter

Fences: Pile of poles on the ground. Riders may only cross enter with Special Beginner and Vertical classes.

3. Pile of Poles Hunter over Fences

Special Beginner Rider Hunter Division

Fences: Very low. Open to beginner riders of all ages. Riders may only cross enter with Pile of Poles and Vertical classes. Judged on performance with emphasis on manners and suitability. Courses will consist of four jumps completed without a change in direction.

5. Special Beginner Rider Hunter Over Fences I
6. Special Beginner Rider Hunter Over Fences II
7. Special Beginner Rider Hunter Under Saddle

Vertical Hunter Division

Fences: 2'. Open to beginner riders of all ages. Riders may only cross enter with Pile of Poles and Special Beginner classes. Judged on performance with emphasis on manners and suitability. Horses may compete twice as separate entries with different riders. May trot or canter courses. Courses will consist of four jumps completed without a change in direction.

Centex Beginner Rider Hunter Division

Fences: 2'. Open to beginner riders who have not won six blue ribbons over fences in Centex divisions prior to the current show year. Riders in this division may not cross enter into divisions with fences higher than 2'6" at this show. Riders may not have ever shown 3' or above. Judged on performance with emphasis on manners and suitability. Courses will consist of 7-10 jumps with at least one change in direction.

Centex Pony Working Hunter Division

Fences: small-2', medium-2'3", large-2'6". Open to junior riders on ponies. Judged on performance, manners and soundness.

Centex Schooling Hunter Division

Fences: 2'3" Open to all. Judged on performance and manners. If entries warrant, class will be split into pro/non-pro sections.

Centex Green Working Hunter Division

Fences: 2'6". Open to horses in their first or second year of showing who have NEVER shown 3'6" or higher at any show. Judged on performance and soundness.

Centex Modified Children's/Adult Hunter Division

Fences: 2'6". Restricted to junior and adult amateur riders. The same horse/rider combination may not compete at the same show in classes with fences 3' or higher (includes Hi-Low Working Hunter). Judged on performance, manners, and soundness.

Fences: very low. Open to beginner riders of all ages. Riders may only cross enter with Pile of Poles and Vertical classes. Course will consist of four jumps completed without a change in direction.

44. Special Beginner Rider Equitation on the Flat

Vertical Equitation Division

Fences: 2'. Open to beginner riders of all ages. Riders may only cross enter with Pile of Poles and Special Beginner classes. Horses may compete twice as separate entries with different riders. May trot or canter course. Course will consist of four jumps completed without a change in direction.

45. Vertical Equitation Over Fences
46. Vertical Equitation on the Flat

Centex Beginner Rider Equitation Division

Fences: 2'. Open to beginner riders who have not won six blue ribbons over fences in Centex divisions prior to the current show season. Riders in this division may not cross enter into divisions with fences higher than 2'6" at this show. Riders may not have ever shown 3' or above. Courses will consist of 7-10 jumps with at least one change in direction.

Centex Pony Equitation Division

Fences: small-2', medium-2'3", large-2'6". Open to junior riders on ponies.

Fences: 2'6"-2'9". Open to all junior and adult amateur riders.

Fences: 3'. Open to junior riders on horses or ponies.

Medal Classes

Centex 2'6" Medal

Fences: 2'6". Open to junior and adult amateur riders not showing in classes with fence heights of 3' or higher at this show. Optional work-off may include USEF Tests 1-9 (EQ119).

59. Centex 2'6" Medal

Centex 3' Medal

Fences: 3'. Open to all junior and adult amateur riders. To be ridden over a course of at least eight fences with at least two changes of direction and an in-and-out. Work-off is optional

60. Centex 3' Medal

Centex Pony Medal

Fences: small-2', medium-2'3", large-2'6". Open to junior riders on ponies. Cannot cross enter into Centex Medal or Centex 2'6" Medal. Must have five entries prior to start of show to run as scheduled.
